<b>GDPR Article 6</b> • Consent for specific purposes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Consent will be collected in each survey.</li> <li>• No respondent can respond without giving consent.</li> <li>• Purpose defined for the consent.</li> </ul>	
<b>GDPR Article 13</b> • Required information to data subject	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All respondents receive required information before responding.</li> </ul>	
<b>GDPR Article 15</b> • Right of access <b>GDPR Article 16</b> • Right to rectification <b>GDPR Article 17</b> • Right to be forgotten <b>GDPR Article 20</b> • Data portability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The required operations can be performed per respondent upon request.</li> </ul>	
<b>GDPR Article 25</b> • Privacy by design and by default	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Requirement to enter purpose.</li> <li>• Valid consent collected and documented from all respondents.</li> <li>• Automatic deletion upon date set by controller.</li> <li>• Controller will itself enter the information and own the process.</li> </ul>	
<b>GDPR Article 30</b> • Records of processing activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The controller will be able to document its processing in the software.</li> </ul>	
<b>GDPR Article 32</b> • Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Questback solutions run on a secure environment as described in the IT Governance Policy.</li> </ul>
